## The Racist Roots of Earth Day

We've just celebrated another "Earth Day," an annual event requiring the political class to demonstrate their commitment to protecting the environment from humanity. On the surface it's a public exercise promoting conservation but its origins and legacy has a much darker past with an even darker future.

The early 1960's produced several tomes on impending doom facing humanity. The Club of Rome promoted Malthusian theory regarding overpopulation and scarcity, predicting famine, war and disease on a Biblical scale if the harshest of measures weren't imposed upon humanity.

In 1968 Paul Ehrlich, Professor of Ecology from Stanford University published "The Population Bomb" which postulated that mass starvation was soon to devastate the earth along with destabilization of civilization. His solution was to impose totalitarian global population control, with the emphasis being upon the burgeoning populations of the less developed countries populated by brown-skinned people with high birth rates. The Club of Rome pounced upon this theme in 1974 with its pronouncement that "The world has cancer and the cancer is Man" (Mankind at the Turning Point, 1974).

The year 1970 saw the birth of the modern environmental movement and in the United States, the Nixon Administration initiated the Environmental Protection Agency (EPA). One of its first actions was to promote the global ban of the pesticide DDT which literally destroyed the progress made in the world towards the control and near eradication of Malaria as a debilitating and fatal disease. This action alone resulted in the deaths of millions children and continues to kill the poor and undernourished globally by the millions. Rachel Carson told us DDT was destroying the environment in her book "Silent Spring," predicting a Spring without our feathered friends, a result of DDT softening the shells of bird eggs. The National Academy of Sciences (NAS) took strong exception to Carson's tome but the media won the day, DDT was banned despite all of the evidence and testimony of distinguished scientists to the contrary. It's reported that Nixon's EPA Director, William Ruckelshaus, didn't even read the NAS report refuting the critics of DDT; his decision being made on purely political motives to assist the Nixon administration in polls leading up to the 1972 presidential election.

The most insidious policies however were the population control measures forcibly implemented across the globe, policies initiated by the United Nations Fund for Population Activities (UNPFA), funded in large part by the United States Agency for International Development (USAID) via the U.S. Department of State. A classified document (leaked in the 1990's) prepared under the aegis of Secretary of State Henry Kissinger, National Security Study Memorandum 200 titled "Implications of Worldwide Population Growth for U.S. Security and Overseas Interests," (also known as the Kissinger Report) put forth the strategy followed for the next half century to forcibly curtail global population in the Third World.

In the name of population control and largely paid for by U.S. taxpayers, the UNPFA instituted a brutally efficient program directed at the world's poorest and most defenseless groups of people using forced sterilization of millions of women, forced abortions, literally up to the moment of birth (and after) and the mandatory implantation of contraceptive devices such as IUDs on peasant women in India, China, Indonesia, Peru and Africa, to name but a few of the 13 priority targeted nations.

Military and police forces used brute force to apprehend unwilling women from "lower classes" such as the "untouchables of India" and indigenous native populations of Peru for forced sterilization and abortions. IUDs banned in the United States as being defective were distributed enmasse to Third World countries. The devices were often unsterilized and given to untrained, unqualified government practitioners to implant them in poor women with dire medical consequences for victimized women.

Communist China enthusiastically adopted the UNPFA doctrine and initiated its infamous "one child policy" using typical brutal totalitarian methods. A Chinese general headed the program with military efficiency, using such barbaric tactics as to give USAID Public Information Officers pause. "Unauthorized" toddlers were reported to be tied to chairs in "dying rooms", denied food and water until they died. There were no exceptions to the one child policy for decades, resulting in deliberate mass starvation and denial of care for female children among village populations, a result of Chinese cultural preference for male children. China recently abandoned the one-child policy, facing societal dislocation with 200 million surplus males to females. India, which adopted similarly harsh population control policies against their "Untouchables" has a male surplus of 37 million. The disruption to Chinese society is severe as was predicted by Liang Zhongtang, a Marxist educator opposed to the policy. He predicted that the policy would require each couple to eventually support seven persons and they'd have no relatives to assist their generation in old age.

In Africa, the UNPFA policy has overwhelmed medical facilities, assisted by corrupt government agents willing to unquestionably accept UNPFA funds. Across swaths of Africa antibiotics and sterilization equipment has been replaced by mountains of contraceptives and devices, leading to medical catastrophes in rural areas. The widespread use of unsterilized hypodermic needles used for popular contraceptives requiring injections at intervals has led to the explosion of AIDs across Africa. It's estimated that 100 million such devices, unsterilized, in untrained hands were distributed in our name using our dollars at the behest of saving the planet from mankind. Excuse me if I don't celebrate the holocaust.

## CREATING THE USA's CONSTITUTION, PART 2 - By Madalyn McDaniel

### Our First Constitution: the Articles of Confederation

The Declaration of Independence, our Constitution and Bill of Rights did not happen quickly or simultaneously. It was eleven years after the Declaration that our U. S. Constitution was signed. But in 1776, we did have the Articles of Confederation which served as our first constitution.

Under the Articles, we had 8 presidents before George Washington. They were appointed to a one year term. The president did not have a lot of power and could only request cooperation from the sovereign states.

Our first president was John Hanson. In 1782 John Hanson established "The Great Seal of the United States" and it is still used today for official government documents and appears on the back of the one dollar bill.

John Hanson also established the 4th Thursday of each November as Thanksgiving Day.

George Washington modified the holiday in 1789 with his resolution, passed by congress, proclaiming Thanksgiving be an official day of prayer thanking God for our country. But, this was many years after President John Hanson first established the official date for Thanksgiving Day.

Our legislature under the Articles consisted of one body, not the bicameral House and Senate we have now. Legislators served a one year term and could be reelected only a couple times and then they were termed out. All of these frequent, short term elections created a government that operated more like a democracy than our current republic.

Under the Articles the federal government was weak and its primary problems were as follows:

- No power to tax & no way to pay the national debt from the cost of the War or to pay for an ongoing national army.
- No power to control trade & states would interfere with national trade treaties and make their own treaties.
- No strong national executive, no national courts, & no authority to enforce legislation.

The sovereign states:


- Collected their own taxes.
- Charged other states import taxes on their goods.
- Allowed their citizens to not pay debts on contracts.
- Could not be compelled to help pay for national debts.
- Could not be compelled help provide for the national defense with money or personnel.
- Printed their own currency. (Imagine Gov. Jerry Brown with the power to print his own money)

Some felt we needed changes in our government. Eventually a Constitutional Convention was called, initially, to revise and amend the Articles of Confederation. In the end, it was decided to write a new Constitution.

The Anti-Federalists were against the new Constitution and opposed to one powerful nation or entity they feared would become tyrannical. They said we should break up into several small republics because liberty can only be preserved in a small territory with a small government. In addition to fear of tyranny, Anti-Federalists objected to the Constitution because while it listed the powers, limitations, and structure of the new government, there was no Bill of Rights for the individual.

The Federalists argued if we became many small republics, each would end up being dominated by the more powerful governments in Europe. They said this will be a republic like no other. We won't have a democracy with majority rule. Federalists said we can avoid the pitfalls of majority rule and tyranny and preserve individual rights if we do these 5 things: 1) separation of powers, 2) bicameral houses, 3) independent judiciary, elected representation, and all states bound together into a larger territory.

Creating and ratifying our Constitution happened long after 1776. It was not a quick, easy process. Next month, I will share information about some of the political maneuvering that went on in order to get the Constitution written, signed, and ratified. Once again proving the human mind's capacity for willful self-deception, the New York Times recently published an article lamenting the victims of 20th century Communism.

But **such an assumption would be wrong!**

No, the "**victims**", according to Times' writer Vivian Gornick, were the thousands of **American communists** who "endured social isolation, financial and professional ruin, and even imprisonment" when sane Americans rebuked their murderous ideology for the unadulterated evil that it was and is.

National Review's **Jonah Goldberg** (whose brilliant and insightful book, "Liberal Fascism," outlines the history of the American progressive movement's embrace of socialism and communism), **summed it up perfectly**: "It seems to me a bit sad and pathetic, that Gornick— and at least to some extent the New York Times — thinks the most important thing to remember from this sad chapter in American life are victims — not of Stalin's mass murder or of Soviet espionage — but the victims of their own stupidity."

Strange indeed. Less than three decades after the fall of the Soviet Union under the moral leadership of U.S. President Ronald Reagan, British Prime Minister Margaret Thatcher, and Pope John Paul II, a growing number of Americans, possibly ignorant of the horrors of Communism, embrace it in principle and in name.

The great irony is this: Only through the blessings of living in a constitutional republic which guarantees their right to hold these views, and of living in a free market economy that not only sustains their basic needs but affords them a level of luxury not even enjoyed by royalty of a half century ago, can they engage in such immoral, historically uninformed indulgence.

Thus we watch in disbelief as an angry, self-proclaimed socialist septuagenarian nearly secures the Democrat presidential nomination, bolstered by throngs of progressive snowflakes who protest and riot in favor of "LGBT rights" and against income inequality and the "evils" of the free market while tweeting from their \$800 iPhones, sipping \$8 cups of coffee, and sporting Che Guevara t-shirts as a form of virtue signaling.

Yet how many of these socialist/communist sympathizers know their beloved Che was Castro's enforcer and executioner? He was nicknamed "The Butcher of La Cabana" for his brutal reign over the La Cabana prison, where political dissenters, including artists and musicians like the ones who idolize him today, were tortured and killed. How many know Chairman Mao slaughtered 10 times more Chinese peasants than the number of Jews killed by Adolf Hitler? How many know that in Stalinist Russia, homosexuality was a crime punishable by imprisonment and hard labor, or that Stalin murdered tens of millions of people?

Why, with mountains of historical evidence documenting the atrocities of these sister ideologies, do we today have millions of Americans who openly embrace them? When faced with a recitation of its evils and failures, a common refrain is that communism/socialism is the ideal form of government; it just hasn't yet been implemented properly. To argue that the failures of communism/socialism — nearly 170 years after the publication of Marx's Communist Manifesto — is a failure of leadership is to argue the movement has been led by crooks or incompetents for nearly two centuries. If so, what does that say about the followers?

Interestingly, it is the clear-eyed proponents of communism/socialism who are the most truthful about what the ideologies are and are not. Friedrich Nietzsche, the nihilist German philosopher who greatly influenced Hitler and his NAZIs (an acronym for the National SOCIALIST German Workers Party), declared, "Socialism is the fantastic younger brother of despotism, which it wants to inherit. Socialism wants to have the fullness of state force which before only existed in despotism."

It would seem that a large number of the Americans who embrace socialism/communism are utterly ignorant of the misery these ideologies birth. According to a recent [YouGov survey](#), nearly **half of Millennials** were unfamiliar with Mao and Che (though they still wear t-shirts emblazoned with their images). A third were unfamiliar with Lenin and Marx. Of course, it doesn't help when the nation's "newspaper of record" has long been [a journalistic fangirl for oppressive regimes](#).

It is such ignorance that turns out tens of thousands of progressive idealists to rallies for **Bernie Sanders**, a self-avowed socialist who decries the evils of capitalism despite having recently bought his third home, this one a \$600,000 vacation home on the shores of Lake Champlain. One thing is for sure; he is living better in evil, capitalist America than he would in Venezuela, the socialist paradise he says we should emulate — a paradise where millions are starving and have no bread, medicine or toilet paper.

In the meantime, oblivious to the irony, good little progressives march and riot against "fascists" in America (a term they define as "anyone who disagrees with them"), demanding free speech protections even as they beat up political opponents.



## What Constitutional Crisis? - Brian Mark Weber, Patriot Post, May 12, 2017

### Remember This Guy?

When Donald J. Trump was sworn in as our nation's 45th president, Democrats experienced an epiphany. They suddenly came to embrace the ideals of the Founding Fathers and to celebrate our Constitution and its separation of powers as the pillars of our civilization. Except that it's all smoke and mirrors. Democrats don't give a wit about the Constitution, and they loathe the very barriers that our Founders put in place to stop lawless, self-serving politicians.

President Trump's firing of FBI director James Comey is a case in point. We knew that the reaction from the Left would be hypocritical, nonsensical and overly dramatic. And we knew Democrats would condemn the firing even though many of them had previously suggested that Comey should be fired. It wasn't even surprising when they said it was wrong for Trump to fire Comey, but a President Hillary Clinton could have done it. But leave it to the Democrats to go off the deep end by claiming that Trump's decision to remove Comey from his post has put us in the midst of a "full-fledged constitutional crisis" — those are the disgraceful words of Hawaii Sen. Brian Schatz, but other Democrats have run around screaming the same thing.

Columnist David Harsanyi writes, "[T]he firing of Comey is not a constitutional crisis until there is evidence that it is. Democrats have spent months impugning Comey's integrity, after all, and most Republicans weren't exactly fans either. When Politico asked a number of experts whether the Comey firing rose to the level of crisis, refreshingly enough, all but one was reluctant to say yes. They were inclined to wait and see what happens."

You see, Democrats aren't really upset that Comey was sent packing. What's really irking them is that they're absolutely convinced Comey was on the precipice of revealing information on Russia and the Trump administration that would have led to impeachment hearings. This isn't a theory or even a hope. They really believe Trump canned Comey to avoid some bombshell revelations that aren't there in the first place.

And this is precisely why President Trump mentioned in his termination letter that Comey told him three times he wasn't under investigation. There is no bombshell. And there certainly isn't a constitutional crisis. The FBI director serves at the pleasure of the president, and the president has the authority to fire him. Plain and simple. We may not like the timing of the decision, we may not like the president's reasoning, or we may not like the optics. But even if Comey had the goods on President Trump and was about to bring down his entire administration, we still wouldn't face a constitutional crisis. All the mechanisms are still in place for the FBI and the Congress to pursue their investigations, and to take them wherever the facts lead.



So if the Comey sacking isn't a constitutional crisis, what is? Keith Wittington, a political scientist from Princeton University, identifies two components that make up a true constitutional crisis: "when important political disputes cannot be resolved within the existing constitutional framework" or when "important political actors threaten to become no longer willing to abide by existing constitutional arrangements or systematically contradict constitutional proscriptions." Clearly, neither of these scenarios apply to the Comey firing. Trump has not exercised any extra-constitutional powers, nor have the powers of any other branch of government been threatened or undermined in the process.

What does a *real* violation of the Constitution look like? Look no further than Barack Obama, who forced Americans to purchase health insurance under penalty of law, who expanded the authority of the executive branch to curtail Second Amendment freedoms, who selectively targeted Christians and conservatives through the IRS, who refused to enforce immigration laws, and who enacted a unilateral treaty (unratified by the Senate) that sent billions of ransom dollars to an Iranian regime that is the world's leading state sponsor of terrorism, and whose nuclear ambitions threaten not only the Middle East but the entire world.

And this is just a short list of actions taken by Obama to either push the Constitution out of the way altogether, to ignore what it clearly states, to change the way it's interpreted, or to dream up presidential powers that our Founders would have found despotic. Our 44th president was lauded by the mainstream media as a constitutional scholar, yet he acted without any regard to the boundaries or limitations of the Constitution on countless occasions. ObamaCare alone has done more to break down the separation of powers and the tenets of federalism than any program since the New Deal. He swore to uphold the Constitution and then simply disregarded it for political expediency and empowerment. Now *that's* a constitutional crisis.

For more than a century, progressives have trampled all over the Constitution, only to treat it as a sacred text when they need to expand their own power or to destroy their political opponents. When Democrats can't get things done through the system of checks and balances designed by the Founders, they simply find a work-around. If Congress doesn't take action, Democrat presidents write executive orders that broadly expand their power. Or they turn to leftist judges who warp the meaning and intent of the Constitution.

Say what you will about Trump's firing of Director Comey. You can call it ill-timed, unprincipled, self-serving, unprecedented, or politically foolish. But you can't call it a constitutional crisis. The only crisis we face today is that Democrats are willing to cloak themselves in the Constitution in order to destroy a president they couldn't defeat at the ballot box.




